The Serenity Garden has been developed by many volunteers since 2020. It is open to everyone and entry is free.



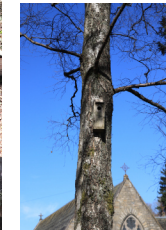
Holy Trinity Church opened in 1858 shortly before the railway arrived in Pitlochry and when most people came to the area in a horse-drawn stagecoach.



The church is often open during the day between April and December and, if you have time, go inside to experience this handsome Victorian building along with its attractive stained glass windows and period furniture.



Near to the Serenity Garden is the gravestone of a man whose 1930s invention gave Britain a significant military advantage during World War Two. The stone will tell you his name and his invention.
